DVS 6000 APPROVED BY LEADING OILFIELD SAFETY AND SERVICE COMPANY FOR VARIETY OF APPLICATIONS

Diversified Industries Ltd. ("Diversified" or the "Company") is pleased to announce that after twelve months of testing and evaluation, the environmental division of a leading oilfield safety and service company has approved our hydrogen sulphide ("H₂S") scavenger, **DVS 6000**, for use in several applications for removing H₂S and various other odour causing contaminants found in the oil & gas and pulp & paper industries. Not only do these applications represent significant sales potential for Diversified, this approval will also open up opportunities with other safety and service companies around the world.

This oilfield safety and service company will be utilizing DVS 6000 in Alberta in a variety of applications with their clients. One of the first applications will be for removing H₂S and for general odour control at a major oilfield waste disposal facility. The DVS 6000 product has been delivered to the first location and the first scrubber will be filled with product early next week. Each scrubber that uses the product will need to be re-filled on a regular basis as the product is spent or used up. This client, a leading oilfield waste disposal company, will determine over the next few weeks which sites they will convert to use DVS 6000 based on the results from the first location.

In Western Canada there are more than 25 sites that are similar in nature and are potential users of the DVS 6000. If each site were to use a minimum of two drums per month, that would represent a minimum of 50 drums per month. There are hundreds of sites similar to these throughout North America. We know the product performs very well when used as a general odour control agent and we are confident that sales in this market will continue to increase.

In addition to the above project, the environmental division of the safety and service company has approved several other applications as follows:

- As a scrubbing agent for sour tanks using straight injection and circulation.
- As a scrubbing agent in fixed scrubbers. Currently this application pertains to the steaming of tanks. The venting process requires all vented steam to pass through a scrubber that contains DVS 6000 to eliminate H₂S and associated odours. (DVS 6000 also impacts other hydrocarbons to control odour).
- As a scrubbing agent in their mobile scrubber systems. These mobile scrubbers would compete with (and replace) other mobile scrubber systems now used in the field as rental or lease units.
- DVS 6000 also works in conjunction with a secondary product supplied by the safety and service company that is pre-injected into the oil/gas waste prior to it entering fixed scrubbers. This secondary product assists in locking up the hydrocarbon molecules to eliminate explosive levels and reduces the H₂S prior to entering the scrubber. This process increases the life of the DVS 6000, making it more cost effective.

The amount of DVS 6000 used by this safety and service company this year will depend on the number of tank cleaning projects, which has been increasing from year to year. They are also promoting the sale of DVS 6000 to other companies and continue to explore other possible applications.

DVS 6000 is a superior H₂S scavenger without the negative qualities of typical scavengers like ammonia, caustic soda or formaldehyde-based products. DVS 6000 is non-flammable, non-corrosive, and is not regulated under the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act of Canada*. In addition, it has a freeze point below minus 45 degrees Celsius, has a non-toxic zinc sulphide by-product and a mild odour. We believe DVS 6000 is the safest and easiest to use H₂S scavenger in the world.
